- **Who:** Students who opted in to the [Spartan.uncg.edu](http://spartan.uncg.edu) pilot email program during the Fall 2007 semester
- **What:** Mail will stop being delivered for the address username@spartan.uncg.edu and access to <http://spartan.uncg.edu> will be removed
- **When:** Monday, June 1, 2009

Please note this is a 2nd notice to all spartan.uncg.edu pilot members. A first notice was sent on May 8, 2009.

You are receiving this message because you opted in to the UNCG Student Email (Spartan Mail) pilot during the Fall 2007 semester. As a part of that pilot, your email address was username@spartan.uncg.edu. Once all students were moved into iSpartan, email addresses became username@uncg.edu. However, UNCG ITS continued to deliver mail for Spartan Pilot members at username@spartan.uncg.edu to give them time to transition fully to iSpartan.

On Monday, June 1, 2009, ITS will remove access to the spartan.uncg.edu domain and will stop delivering mail for username@spartan.uncg.edu. This means that beginning June 1st 2009:

- Email sent to username@spartan.uncg.edu will be bounced back to the sender. *NOTE - If you have subscribed to any listservs with the address username@spartan.uncg.edu, you will want to resubscribe to those lists.*
- You will no longer be able to login to <http://spartan.uncg.edu> to access any mail that may still be there. If you have any data (mail, calendar or contacts) in your spartan.uncg.edu account that you would like to continue to access, you will need to login and forward it to your iSpartan account before June 1, 2009.
